



Coaching Course Provision Policy

1. All coaches who mentor a juvenile team will be provided with access to a child Protection course at no cost to the individual*;
2. All coaches who mentor a club team will be provided with access to GAA Foundation Coaching Course at no cost to the individual*;
3. All coaches who mentor a club team and require funding for all additional GAA recognised courses (Level one or level two coaching, first aid), the club will pay up to a **maximum of £50** contribution towards the total cost of such a course*. Supported Participants of such a course will be required to sign “A Good Faith Agreement” which will commit the participants to provide **three years** further coaching services to club teams;
4. Financial support for additional personal development courses (e.g. coaching development sessions), the participant must submit an official request by email to the secretary of the club at least **one month** before the course date, which will then be subject to approval for half payment at the next club committee meeting. Participants of such a course will be required to sign “A Good Faith Agreement” which will commit the participants to provide **three years** further coaching services to club teams.

*** The club will pay all/£50 max course fees for this course but will not be responsible for any travel or subsistence costs associated with attending this course.**
